## Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana

August 2014

Around 28 crore bank accounts opened, receiving Rs 36,000 crore in deposits

## Skill Development and Skill India



The target is to skill 40.2 crore workers by 2022. In Financial Year 2015-16, number of people trained was 28.85 lakhs (as of October 2015), meeting merely 23.64% of the year's target

## Make in India

September 2014

India registered FDI equity inflows of \$40 billion in 2015-16, though industrial output grew by only 2.4 per cent in the same period

## Digital India



A ₹4.5 lakh crore initiative – by government and the private sector – to create a digital infrastructure to offer governance and services to citizens. 50,400 gram panchayats connected with 1,40,751 km of optical fibre cable

## Swachh Bharat

October 2014

The government has build 8 million new toilets of the planned 110 million across India by 2019. However the patterns of toilet usage have not changed much, given the preference to open defecation

## Sansad Aadarsh Gram Yojana



Likely to miss the target to develop three Aadarsh Grams by March 2019, and one by 2016. MPs have not been enthusiastic as there are no special fund allocation for the scheme

## Atal Pension Yojana

May 2014

Till date 26.3 lakh subscribers have registered for the pension scheme

## Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojan



Launched with an outlay of Rs 76,000 crore, 5,86,786 villages have been electrified (98.2% of census villages)

July 2015



## Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana

May 2015

There have been 9.4 crore enrolment, with 5,391 claims

## Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana



Gross enrolment in this programme are pegged at 2.96 crore subscribers with total reported claims of 26,567

## Smart City Mission

June 2015

Out of 100 smart cities, the government has given go ahead for 20 cities only. Next clearance is expected in June 2016

## Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana



Cabinet has approved Rs. 80,000 crore for rural areas

## Namami Gange

May 2015

93 projects has been approved at the cost of Rs.7350.38 crores for creating treatment capacity (till Dec 2015)

## Start Up India



Government has taken up funding requests of 30 companies, no money disbursed yet

## Stand Up India

April 2016

Government to facilitate bank loans between Rs 10 lakh and Rs 1 Crore to at least one SC enterprise or ST borrower and at least one woman borrower per bank branch (total branch 1.25 lakh) for setting up a greenfield ebterprise

## Ujala Yojna



More than 10 crore LED blubs have been distributed, it will save Rs 40,000 crore annually

## Give it Up

March 2015

Over 1 crore customers have given up LPG subsidy, saving the government Rs 5,178 crore in petroleum subsidy bill

## Beti Bachhao Beti Padhao



Government claims improvement in sex ratio in 49 districts

January 2015



## Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana

May 2016

Plans to provide five crore LPG connections to people below the poverty line

## Micro Units Development Refinance Agency



Claims to have disbursed Rs 1.25 lakh crore in the past year but there are allegations that loans have been given to existing depositors
